

## STANDARDIZED COMPETITION TERMINOLOGY

Skate Canada has adopted standardized language for competitions. This language should be used for all competitions, wherever possible, whether the judging system used is OBO or CPC. It should be used in all competition documents, not just those documents prepared by the Data Specialists, including the Announcement and Programs.

**EVENT** ...This is now used instead of Competition

**CATEGORY** ...Refers to Novice Women Singles, Pre-Novice Dance, Junior Pair, etc.

- Within CATEGORIES, the disciplines are:
  - Men
  - Women
  - Pair
  - Dance

**SEGMENT** ...Refers to the parts of a Category, for example, Compulsory Dance, Pattern Dance, Short Program, Short Dance, Free Program, and Free Dance

**SECTIONS** ...The following abbreviations should be used for the Skate Canada Sections:

- BC/YT ..... British Columbia
- AB/NT/NU ... Alberta
- SK ..... Saskatchewan
- MB ..... Manitoba
- WO ..... Western Ontario
- NO ..... Northern Ontario
- CO ..... Central Ontario
- EO ..... Eastern Ontario
- QC ..... Quebec
- NB ..... New Brunswick
- NS ..... Nova Scotia
- PE ..... Prince Edward Island
- NL ..... Newfoundland

**CLUBS** ...Clubs should be shown by their name only without the addition of FSC, SC, CPA, etc.
